Parker's Story

This is a story of a Mother who never gave up. From the moment Parker was born 22 years ago, Terrie, his mother, knew in her heart that something was wrong. Her son's of his mouth and his



tongue was hanging out eyes were crossed. Pedia-

tricians referred him to other specialists. At nine months, he was not sitting. He had eye surgery, yet there were no changes.

When Parker was 2 1/2 years old, he was labeled as having Cerebral Palsy and having problems with asthma, ear infections,

constipation, and bed wetting (Cerebral Palsy is a term which encompasses a set of neurological conditions that cause physical disability and slow development. In many cases, it is now referred to as "Failure to Thrive.").



After many years of therapy without much change, he could not walk independently, was braced, and could speak 50 to 100 words that

only his mother could understand. The doctors advised his parents to take him home, love him, and see how he turns out.

Terrie learned that people were trained to hide dysfunction, so no expectations were given for her child. Nothing was helping. Parker acted out and threw his plate at meals. After Terrie was told to get him a special dish with a suction cup, she drew the line.

Real help came when Parker was six. A friend, who had taken her child to Oklahaven, suggested that Terrie take Parker there as well.

After Parker's first adjustment, he went to his grandparent's house, opened the refrigerator and announced, "I'm hungry." Everyone was astonished to hear Parker speak and have the strength to open the refrigerator door. Terrie immediately made a commitment to bring Parker for intensive Chiropractic care. With daily adjustments, small improvements led to bigger changes in Parker's life. He learned to walk, feed himself, read, write, and dress himself.

When he returned to school, he was about to be labeled in the ADHD spectrum, but was a Cerebral Palsy child in the upward spiral of health. He was then homeschooled, and a happier child.

For Parker, nothing came easy and it still requires Terrie's ongoing commitment to heal her son. They have come to Oklahaven every month for the past 15 years. -Terrie recognizes that it is the chiropractic premise that the power that made the body heals the body. As the life force increases within the body with time, it restores the body to its optimal potential. Terrie has said many times, "If I stop now, that's where Parker stops."

As time progressed, Parker improved, but was very hypersensitive to subtle and loud noises especially at malls, ball games and events. The family could only go to certain places and restaurants.

Today Parker is able to do things without constant supervision giving Terrie more time for her daily activities. Since he has improved balance and coordination, he is able to use the restroom by himself and is now able to stay overnight with friends and relatives. His current challenge, like all of us, is keeping his anger under control.

Some things that used to bother Parker are now the things that he loves. He has learned to play the piano and enjoy music. He flies his radio controlled blimp, and became a Laughter Yoga Leader. The



clinic comes alive the moment he walks through the door, with a smile from ear to ear. Parker laughs his unique laugh as everyone joins in with his contagious laughter, and he changes to his Texas/Oklahoma accent with, "Heeey! How are y'all"? He also volunteers at an assisted living center in his home town. Most amazing of all, **Parker participated in a 5k run** last spring. This is incredible for a child labeled as having Cerebral Palsy.

What Terrie wants all parents to know is that if she had ended chiropractic care, that's where Parker's development would have stopped! Parker is beginning to reach his optimal potential.

Because the chiropractic lifestyle gave Terrie and her son a life with more freedom and joy, Parker wants to invite everyone to "Help heal the hurt children." He hands out hearts and wishes everyone to join in **Oklahaven "Have-A-Heart" campaign.**

We are pleased to introduce our new Executive Director, **Frank San Antonio**, a former banker who has served on our Board since 1998. He brings a wealth of knowledge, tremendous organizational skills, and a true com-

Recipe-Fresh Ginger Beer

I love this drink because ginger works as an anti-inflammatory, lemon detoxes, mineral water adds a variety of minerals, and raw honey improves resistance to allergies and helps with the healing process. Every ingredient serves a purpose.

I used sparkling water, however, regular water can be used. Real, sparkling mineral water can be hard to find – most are artificially carbonated. Visit your local health food store to find real, sparkling mineral water that has been bottled at the source. Example – Apollinaris.

- 1 liter sparkling mineral water
- 3-5 inches of fresh ginger root or to taste
- I/2 cup lemon juice

Use a spoon to scrape off the skin of the ginger root. Grate ginger with a microplane and strain out the ginger juice in a fine strainer. Pour the ginger and lemon juice into the sparkling mineral water. Optional: add raw honey as needed and stir well.
