

## Questioning Fetal Ultrasounds

### Is ultrasound destined to follow the path of x-rays?

A spiritual and higher vibrational aspect of an issue that has come to my awareness of late. How safe are ultrasounds?

In 1919, a patent was filed for an x-ray machine that helped sell shoes. Customers didn’t need it to find well-fitting shoes, but people loved seeing images of their foot bones.

It wasn’t until the 1940s that scientists and regulators began to raise concerns about the levels of radiation these machines produced. It took another two decades for states to begin banning or restricting their use. Today the hazards of x-rays are well documented.

I’m beginning to question the safety of unrestricted fetal ultrasound. In my practice I’m noticing how newborns aren’t moving as much as they once did, and last-minute ultrasounds seem to precipitate the sudden need for emergency cesarean section.

According to the free dictionary, “ultra” means something that’s excessive or extreme...beyond the range. This isn’t ordinary sound that we’re bombarding fetuses with. I wonder if the ultrasound is like a dog whistle. We can’t hear it but the dog certainly does. Do fetuses hear ultrasound? It is common that the baby moves around in the womb during an ultrasound. Are the sound waves loud and disturbing? Or perhaps, like x-rays in the 1920s and 30s, there’s an imbalance we

haven't yet learned to measure.

## Viewing this from a higher perspective,

I see sound as spiritual atoms moving the manifestation of God into the physical. The light and sound realized together are the voice of God, the Holy Spirit, like a baby that comes through the mother. They form a cosmic wave, like T.V. and radio, that goes out from the heart to the ends of creation. These manifestations of God creation make the Audible Life Stream...the life current. This keeps the sun coming up, the moon coming up each day, the grass keeps coming, and our hair keeps growing.

I'm seeing newborns who are lethargic, lifeless, and dull—even though they smile. With adjustments I watch: the light return to their eyes, the center line of their face comes in, eyes straighten and begin to work together, Sound begins to be heard with both ears and the expressions on their faces begin to show. They interact better with their parents. They pass through the developmental milestones of creeping, crawling, standing, and walking.

A clue may be found in the color-ray-spectrum evaluation practiced by practitioners of the Gemstone Therapy Institute. Its founder has noticed an excessive amount of yellow in the fetal spectrum of those subjected to multiple ultrasounds. Applying a TheraDiamond and Yellow Sapphire in a certain way eases the excess and returns the spectrum to a healthy, balanced one. Research has yet to be done on this fascinating topic.

The Chiropractic adjustment can resolve some of the potentially harmful effects of ultrasound along with the TheraDiamond. However, I do feel that a lot of this is cumulative.

It is time we begin to look at the potential damage to the fetus and ask why are we inflicting unnecessary ultrasound on the fetus... our children...the future.
